Hanga-Aro-Rau is the Workforce Development Council (WDC) for the Manufacturing, Engineering and Logistics industries.

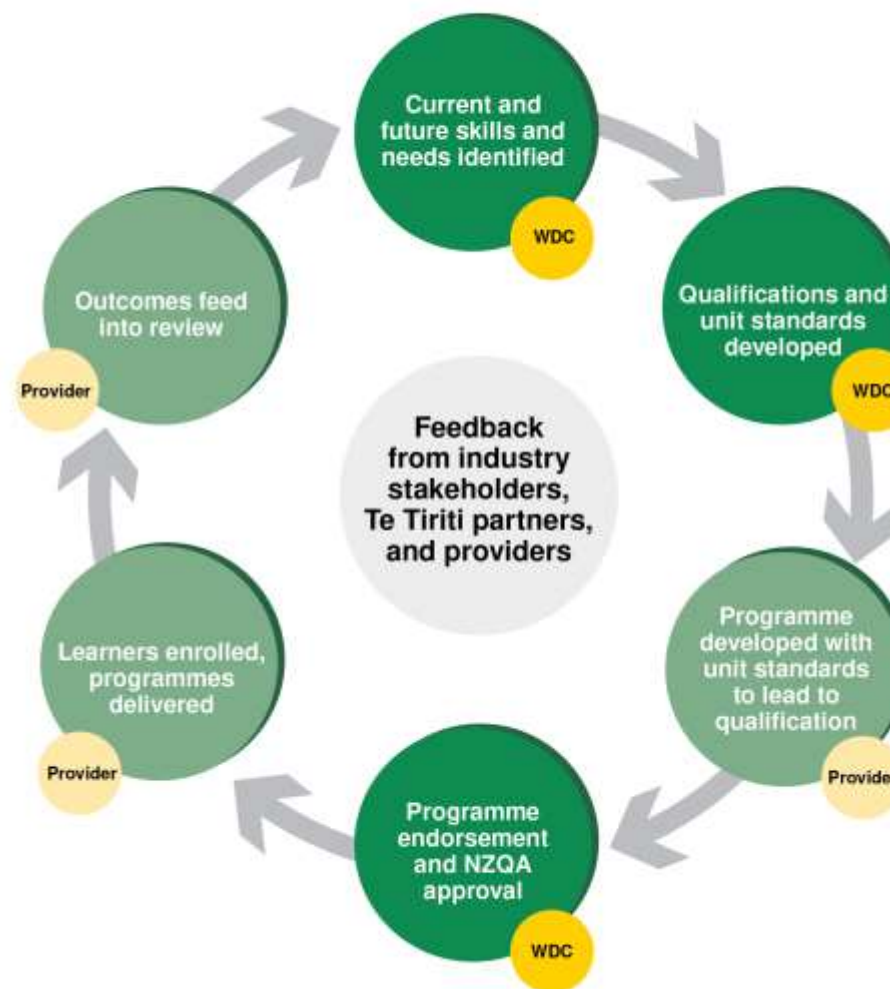
Hanga-Aro-Rau's role is to:

What does the provider do?

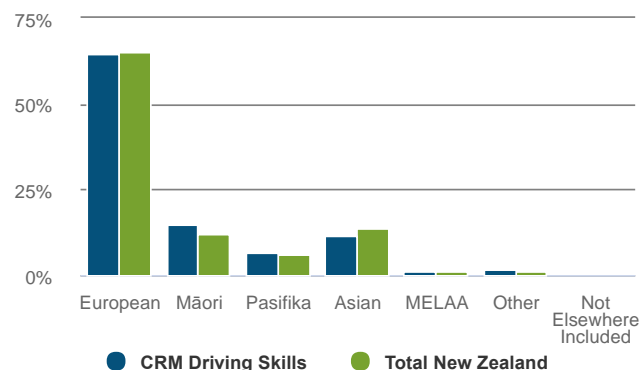
The provider's role is to:

Driving Skills Statistics

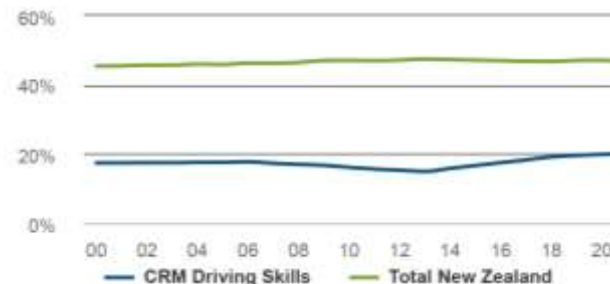
What was the ethnicity of workers in 2018?



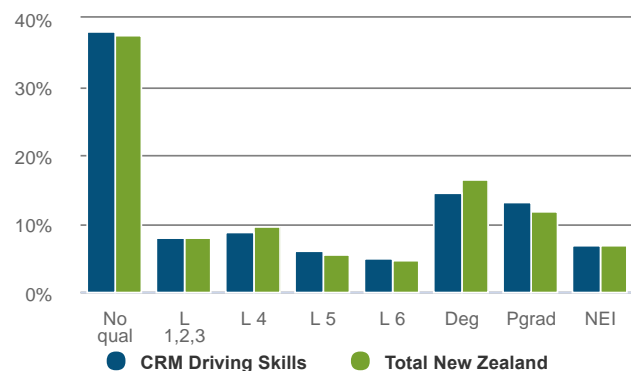
How many workers were female in 2021?

20.1% female

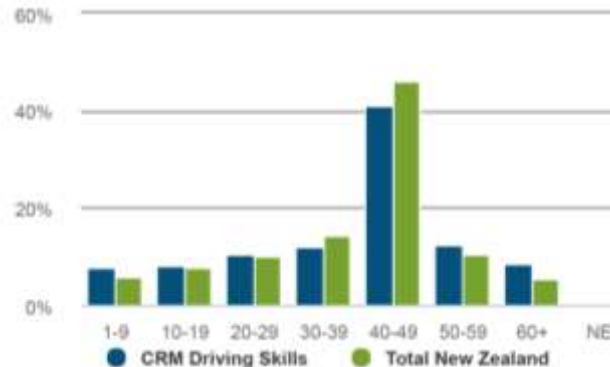
Total New Zealand: 46.9%
