Resolved that the NZIDE Constitution 2018 Rule 20 (now NZIDE Constitution 2021) has the following paragraph added as requested by the Inland Revenue Department

If upon winding up or dissolution of the organisation there remains after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever the same shall not be paid or distributed among the members of the organisation but shall be given or transferred to some other organisation or body with similar objects to the first organisation or for some other charitable purpose, within New Zealand.

 Motion that the resolution on rule 13(a)(iii) of the NZIDE Constitution at the NZIDE Annual General Meeting 26 August 2022 be accepted;

Resolved that the NZIDE Constitution rule 13(a)(iii) be changed to read

The appeal board shall consist of three persons, one being nominated by the Executive and being himself/herself an Executive member, one being nominated by the appellant (such nominee being not necessarily a member of the Institute) and one being a consensual dispute resolution provider (for example, mediation, facilitation, or a tikanga-based practice). The decision of the appeal board shall be final. The appeal board shall have jurisdiction to make an order as to payment of the costs of the appeal.
