Weight is given to situations not published in newsletters on the Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency portal for driver training and testing¹. Categories for the award include one or more of the following: • Specific local intersections commonly failed in a test • Technically correct signaling that is situationally confusing to others • Grey area's of testing or training no one seems to answer
Give a brief description and or, when relevant, a picture of the situation or road markings. If applicable, say the common mistakes. Optional, share what you understand is the correct response. This award is about the conundrum. However, judges will consider responses given. Responses might include supporting arguments from the road code, regulation, case law, review findings, determination, regulation or legislation. If you can't support the correct response, share your interpretation of the intent behind any relevant road user rule. Bottom line, share your favourite conundrum! Self nonminations accepted. Feel free to submit as a team or as a region!
